STUDENT COMMITMENT

PARENT/GUARDIAN COMMITMENT

1. I understand that it is my/our Biblical responsibility to train my child(ren) spiritually. I will be faithful in attendance at my Bible-believing church with my child(ren).
2. I am familiar with the rules and expectations of students as outlined in the Parent/Student Handbook and support them.
3. I realize it is my responsibility to ensure that my child(ren) abides by the rules and expectations of ECA as stated in the Parent/Student Handbook. It is my responsibility to make certain that my child(ren) does not participate in any activity in school and out of school that would damage the name of Christ and the testimony of ECA.
4. Because I/we are choosing to partner with ECA, I agree to support the school and its faculty and staff in front of my child. I will also insist that my child show respect toward school personnel at all times.
5. I understand that ECA reserves the right to dismiss any student who does not comply with its spiritual or academic standards, fully cooperate in the academic process, or does not respond appropriately to discipline. I also agree to authorize the school to employ such discipline, as it deems necessary for my child(ren), according to the Parent/Student Handbook.
6. I understand that the administration will be making the final decision regarding placement of my child(ren) as far as room, teacher, and class assignment is concerned.
7. I give permission for my child(ren) to take part in all school activities, including sports and school-sponsored trips away from campus, and absolve the school from liability to me or my child because of any injury to my child.
8. If I am not able to provide health insurance for my child(ren) while enrolled at ECA, I will not hold the school responsible for any claims from a student injury that may occur during school hours or due to involvement in extra-curricular activities.

TUITION AGREEMENT

1. I pledge to pay my financial obligations to ECA on the date due and understand that a late fee of \$10 will be assessed when payment has not been made by the 10th of the month.
2. If my tuition account falls 30 days in arrears, it is my responsibility to contact the Business Office to work out an acceptable payment plan. In the event no fitting arrangements are made, the school reserves the right to take measures that will secure payment. ECA wishes to settle disputes (financial and otherwise) in an amicable and Biblical manner. **If my account falls 60 days behind at any point during the school year, my child(ren), except for extenuating circumstances, will be dismissed from school.**
3. If my account is more than 30 days in arrears, I may not re-enroll my child(ren) for the next school year until the account is current. This would mean my child(ren) would lose their chronological place on any given class list, and in the event of a full class, my child(ren) would go to the waiting list(s).
4. In an effort to encourage families with seniors to meet their financial obligations, graduating seniors with past due tuition balances will not receive their diplomas until all accounts have been settled. Likewise, transcripts of seniors going on to college will not be sent until all financial obligations have been met.
5. In the event that a student transfers during the course of the year, the Business Office will prorate tuition according to the number of days the student was enrolled. Tuition is prorated for students who enroll after the start of the school year. I understand that students withdrawing from ECA before the end of the school year will also be assessed a withdrawal fee of \$250 per student.
6. No student/family will be reimbursed for time a student was not in school due to sickness, vacation, etc.

By signing this document, I agree to the aforementioned terms of the Parent/Guardian Commitment and the Tuition Agreement. This document must be signed in order for enrollment to be official.
